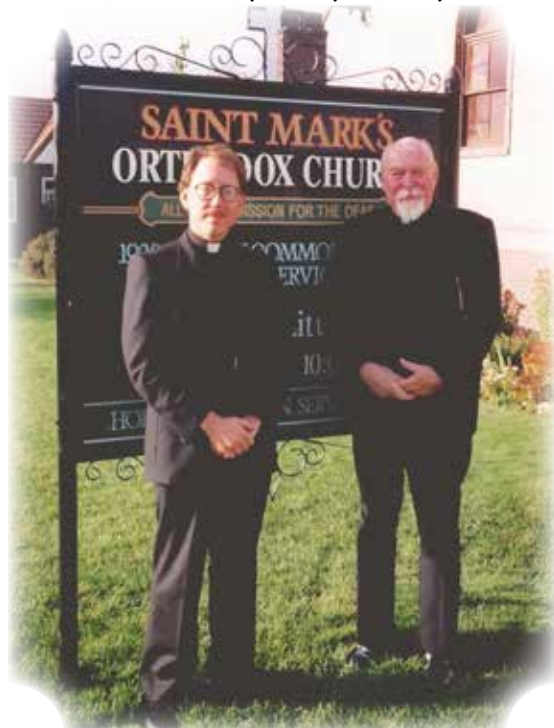

Then, we could rent St. Thomas' Seminary for 70 registered visitors, many of whom became Orthodox afterwards and served the Church as Priests, Deacons, pious Laity, for years after. Seven communities and a monastery resulted with properties and clergy assigned and numbers of youths in Camps. *Deo gratia.*
